Middle School Eligibility and Contests

This means that students grades in all classes must be above 70 on the progress report or report card at the latest eligibility check date before we go to contest in order to participate. What you need to know for now is: grades in all classes are important, and its important to get a grade of 70 or higher; we will be checking grades for all band students in all classes and will be discussing any problems with them individually.
